In 2025, United Way of the CSRA served as both a direct service provider and a community impact catalyst, ensuring that families had the stability, access, and support needed to succeed.

72

ALICE households received free tax preparation from our VITA (Volunteer Income Tax Assistance) program. This equates to \$81,056 that was saved and returned to families through federal and state tax refunds.

Through the work of our partner agencies, 136 individuals gained employment, and 105 individuals experienced wage growth
